**Rosen Supports Virtual Visitation Statute
in North Carolina**

Currently in North Carolina, virtual visitations are sometimes agreed to in child custody hearings, but usually between the parties, not as a court order. "Making this legislation would grant more authority to the judges and sometimes it's not clear what they can do," says Rosen.
